

FAQ - All India Level Drawing Contest 2024

Q1. Where can schools get the School Registration Form for the competition?

Registration form can be found @ www.isprieth.com

Q2. How do we register for All India Level Drawing Contest 2024?

Steps to be followed by the school before starting the registration process.

1. School level contest coordinator must be selected and appointed by each school.
2. Circular/Message regarding the contest must be sent to the parents.
3. Interested students can register their names to the respective class teacher. Each student should pay the entry fee of Rs.100 for each contest.
4. Class teachers should submit the name list and entry fees to the contest coordinator at the stipulated time given by the school Principal.
5. Contest coordinator should consolidate the name list category wise (Category A – Class I & Class II, Category B – Class III to Class V, Category C – Class VI to Class VIII & Category D – Class IX to Class XII)

Steps to be followed by the school for registration.

Step 1: Read all the instructions given at www.isprieth.com

Step 2: Pay the registration fee.

Note: The school shall retain Rs.20/- per entry towards the honorarium of the invigilator and other expenditures like photocopying and postal expenses, etc...

Registration fee can be transferred online to the following account.

Step 3: Save a copy of the online payment transaction's screenshot.

Step 4: Click the "School Registration Link" in our website www.isprieth.com and fill out the basic details about school, contact details of School, Principal & School Contest Coordinator; upload the screenshot of the registration fee transaction details.

Q3. What should the schools do after completing registration?

Schools which complete registration process will receive a SCHOOL CODE and attendance sheet format from Isprieth Academy. Schools are requested to mention the school code in all the correspondence (Letter, email, and telephonic conversation).

Schools can motivate the participants to prepare well for the contest.

Q4. What is the entry fee of All India Level Drawing Contest 2024?

A participation fee @ Rs.100/- per participant shall be collected by the school. **The school shall retain Rs.20/- per entry** towards the honorarium of the invigilator and other expenditures like photocopying and postal expenses, etc.

Q5. What are the important dates to be remembered?

Date of Contest: Schools can choose any convenient date between 18 July 2024 and 18 November 2024 for the contest.

Registration Deadline: Two weeks before your chosen contest date.

Q7. How many categories are there in the contest?

There are four categories.

Category A: Class I & II (Colouring Contest)

Category B: Class III to V (Drawing Contest)

Category C: Class VI to VIII (Drawing Contest)

Category D: Class IX to XII (Drawing Contest)

Q8. Where is this contest conducted?

This contest is conducted in your school in the presence of your school contest coordinator and supporting teachers.

Q9. When should the schools conduct this competition?

Date of Contest: Schools can choose any convenient date between 18 July 2024 and 18 November 2024 for the contest.

Registration Deadline: Two weeks before your chosen contest date.

Q10. How should the school conduct this contest?

1. Suitable hall / room must be allotted by the school to organise the contest.
2. Reminder regarding the drawing contest must be sent to the participants on the previous day. Participants must be instructed to bring all required materials for the contest (Chart, brushes, water colours, pastels, pencils, etc.). Schools can make their own arrangement too. The painting should be done in A4 or A3 size chart paper.
3. Contest coordinator and supporting teachers must organise the contest in the allotted hall / room either in the morning or in the afternoon session. Supporting teachers should get sign from the participants in the attendance sheet. The spelling of each student must be free from spelling mistake in the attendance sheet. The same name will be printed on the Merit/Participation Certificate.
4. Students should write their Name, Class & Section, Contact Number, E-mail id of the Student/Parent, Address & Phone Number of School and School Code at the backside of their drawing entry.

Category A (Colouring Contest)

Topic: Protect endangered species

Duration: 2 Hours

Venue: Your School

Students will color an endangered animal picture available for download on our website. Schools must distribute copies on the contest day.

Category B (Drawing Contest)

Topic: Protect endangered species

Duration: 2 Hours

Venue: Your School

Category C & D (Drawing Contest)

Topic: Climate Change: Draw the impact of climate change on the world

Duration: 2 Hours

Venue: Your School

5. Paintings must be collected and handed over to the contest coordinator. **Paintings must be arranged as per the student order mentioned in the attendance sheet and packed category wise in separate covers.**

Paintings must be kept ready to be sent to Isprieth Academy on the same day of the contest.

Q11. What should we do after the contest is conducted?

- **Paintings must be arranged as per the student order mentioned in the attendance sheet and packed category wise in separate covers.**
- Attendance sheet must be packed in a separate cover.
- The covers of Category A, B, C & D and Attendance sheet must be packed in a single large cover/parcel.
- The cover/parcel must be sent to the following address by speed post, registered post or courier on the same day of the contest.
