

# FAQ – 12th All India Level Drawing Contest 2026

Theme: “The Impact of AI on Earth” — An Isprieth Academy National Initiative

## 1. Where can schools get the School Registration Form for the competition?

The registration form can be found at [www.isprieth.com](http://www.isprieth.com).

## 2. How do we register for the All India Level Drawing Contest 2026?

### Steps to be followed by the school before starting the registration process:

- A school-level contest coordinator must be selected and appointed by each school.
- A circular or message regarding the contest must be sent to the parents.
- Interested students can register their names with their respective class teacher. Each student should pay the entry fee of Rs.100 for the contest.
- Class teachers should submit the name list and entry fees to the contest coordinator within the time given by the Principal.
- The contest coordinator should consolidate the name list category-wise (Category A – Grade I & II, Category B – Grade III to V, Category C – Grade VI to VIII, and Category D – Grade IX to XII).

### Steps to be followed by the school for registration:

1. **Step 1:** Visit [www.isprieth.com](http://www.isprieth.com) and read all the contest guidelines and terms.
2. **Step 2:** Keep the participants list ready category-wise in Excel format (school name and address must be included in the file). Each student’s name must be free from spelling mistakes, as the same name will be printed on the Merit/Participation Certificate.
3. **Step 3:** Pay the registration fee using one of the payment methods below. The school shall retain Rs.20/- per entry towards the honorarium of the invigilator and other expenses such as photocopying and postal charges.

4. **Step 4:** Save a copy of the online payment transaction screenshot.
5. **Step 5:** Complete your registration using the link provided on our website — fill in the basic details about the school, along with the contact details of the School, Principal, and School Contest Coordinator, and upload the participants list and the payment screenshot.

## 3. What should schools do after completing registration?

Schools that complete the registration process will receive a **SCHOOL CODE** and an attendance sheet format from Isprieth Academy. Schools are requested to mention the school code in all correspondence (letter, email, and telephonic conversation).

Schools can motivate participants to prepare well for the contest, exploring the theme creatively and confidently.

#### 4. What is the entry fee for the All India Level Drawing Contest 2026?

A participation fee of **Rs.100/- per participant** shall be collected by the school. The school shall retain Rs.20/- per entry towards the honorarium of the invigilator and other expenses like photocopying and postal charges, etc.

Minimum entries required: **50 per school** (no maximum limit).

#### 5. What are the important dates to remember?

**Date of Contest:** Schools may select any convenient date between **20 July 2026 and 20 November 2026** to conduct the contest at their own premises.

**Registration Deadline:** At least two weeks before your chosen contest date.

#### 7. How many categories are there in the contest, and what are this year's themes?

There are four categories, each with its own age-appropriate theme exploring **“The Impact of AI on Earth.”**

- **Category A** (Class I & II – Colouring Contest): **“Make Earth a Healthy Planet”**
- **Category B** (Class III to V – Drawing Contest): **“The Impact of AI on Earth”**
- **Category C** (Class VI to VIII – Drawing Contest): **“The Impact of AI on Earth”**
- **Category D** (Class IX to XII – Drawing Contest): **“The Impact of AI on Earth”**

#### 8. Where is this contest conducted?

This contest is conducted at your own school, in the presence of your school contest coordinator and supporting teachers.

#### 9. When should schools conduct this competition?

**Date of Contest:** Schools may select any convenient date between **20 July 2026 and 20 November 2026** to conduct the contest at their own premises.

**Registration Deadline:** At least two weeks before your chosen contest date.

#### 10. How should the school conduct this contest?

- A suitable hall or room must be allotted by the school to organise the contest.

- A reminder regarding the drawing contest must be sent to participants the previous day. Participants must bring all required materials for the contest (chart, brushes, watercolours, pastels, pencils, etc.). Schools may also make their own arrangements. The artwork should be done on A4 or A3 size chart paper.
- The contest coordinator and supporting teachers must organise the contest in the allotted hall/room, either in the morning or afternoon session. Supporting teachers should obtain signatures from participants on the attendance sheet. Each student's name must be free from spelling mistakes, as the same name will be printed on the Merit/Participation Certificate.
- Artworks must be collected and handed over to the contest coordinator. **Artworks must be arranged as per the student order mentioned in the attendance sheet and packed category-wise in separate covers.**
- Students should write their Name, Class & Section, Contact Number, Email ID of Student/Parent, Address & Phone Number of School, and School Code on the back of their entry.

### Category A (Colouring Contest)

**Theme:** Make Earth a Healthy Planet

**Duration:** 2 Hours

**Venue:** Your School

### Category B, C & D (Drawing Contest)

**Theme:** The Impact of AI on Earth

**Duration:** 2 Hours

**Venue:** Your School

## 11. What should we do after the contest is conducted?

- **Artworks must be arranged as per the student order mentioned in the attendance sheet and packed category-wise in separate covers.**
- The attendance sheet must be packed in a separate cover.
- The covers of Category A, B, C & D, along with the attendance sheet, must be packed in a single large cover/parcel.
- The cover/parcel must be sent to the following address by Speed Post, Registered Post, or courier on the same day as the contest:
